Welcome to the first East Africa Apologetics Leaders Summit!

Adventurous Apologetics is grateful for your participation in this landmark event. You have been invited because your voice and insights matter in the effort to raise apologetics in the body of Christ in Africa and the world.

With about 20 leaders from Kenya, Uganda, Rwanda, and the USA, we'll spend several days collaborating on leading the growth of apologetics, with three main goals:

1. Gain visibility and **awareness** of who is doing what in apologetics in the region
2. Build and strengthen **relationships** that will lead to greater collaboration
3. Discover answers to key questions for the growth of apologetics, and outline concrete **actions** to address these

PROGRAM

- ◆ **Leader and Ministry Presentations.** We have asked key leaders to present a brief overview of their ministries. These will be 20 minutes followed by 10 minutes of Q&A, and they will cover: Who they are, what they do, who their target is, how they do it, what the top challenges are, and their basic plan over the next several years.
- ◆ **Workshop Sessions.** We will all participate in facilitated "workshops" to tackle key topics in the growth of apologetics. There will be key questions to answer, and suggested action items to develop. You will be assigned to one of two "breakout teams," and participate in this activity.
- ◆ **Relationship Building.** During meals, breaks, and before and after our scheduled events are times to build and strengthen relationships as the unique part of the body of Christ called to defend and contend for our faith. We encourage this informal time to grow these foundational relationships.
